Certification and Agreement:

Ogden-Weber Technical College (OTEC) signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the Dept. of Education (DOE) on April 17, 2020. The college assured that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.

Method used to determine which students receive emergency financial aid grants and how much they receive:

FALL 2021 - Student Grant evaluation process

- Be an enrolled adult student with an active schedule between 10/01/2021 and 12/31/2021
- No OTECH progress and attendance or program restrictions
- Completed 2021-2022 FAFSA or a completed OTECH Income Statement form when needed
 - 'Completed' means that statement of family size, income, and any changes in those two criteria between 2019 and now, have been reasonably verified by OTECH systems or staff.
 - No other typical restrictions (i.e. loan default status, citizenship, drug conviction, etc.) indicated by submitted FAFSAs applied to eligibility for HEERF grant.
- EFCs of completed FAFSAs are reviewed in consideration of 'exceptional need' criteria
 - Dependent students with an EFC of 10,451 or less meet criteria
 - Independent students with and EFC of 15,140 or less meet criteria
- Students' enrollment status determines maximum amount of grant
 - Students can receive a max of \$1,845.
 - Previous HEERF payments were considered and subtracted from a student's max eligibility.
 - Current and future HEERF grant awarding will max at \$1,845 per student. This is the tuition amount and enrollment fee listed on OTECH FY22 Cost of Attendance.

Results:

- 422 eligible
- 245 awarded
- 177 notified
