

Shopping Sheet Information for Veterans/Dependents of Veterans

Section 1018 of Public Law 116-315, Johnny Isakson and David P. Roe, M.D. Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020, requires educational institutions to make certain disclosures to students using federal military and/or VA education benefits. To ensure compliance with the law, we have developed this Shopping Sheet Information for Student Veterans/Veteran's Dependents.

Estimated Cost of Course Including tuition, fees, books, supplies, other additional costs

The cost of tuition and fees are the same as a UT resident. For information on the estimated cost, please visit College Navigator - National Center for Education Statistics. Please note that your final cost depends on you receiving VA benefits to cover for tuition and fees, books/supplies, and housing allowance; any aid to cover for the cost; taking extra courses such as prerequisites; retaking a failed course; changing your program of study which requires more or less credits, change in cost of living; a change in tuition/fees as approved by State Legislature, etc. Students should also visit Ogden-Weber Technical College website for tuition, fees, and refund policy [Student Tuition, Fees, and Refunds Policy \(otech.edu\)](http://otech.edu).

Amount of cost covered by VA benefits

Only Chapter 33 recipients may be entitled to a percentage of the following VA Educational Benefits based on your length of Service:

- Cost of tuition and fees for an in-State student (paid to the school and prorated based on the eligibility percentage)
- Monthly housing allowance equal to the basic allowance for housing payable to a military E-5 with dependents, in the same zip code as your school (paid to the student and prorated based on training time and the eligibility percentage)
- Yearly book and supply stipend of up to \$1000 per year (paid to the student @ \$84 per month of the enrollment period per unit and prorated based on the eligibility percentage) VA benefit recipients can visit the following pages for information regarding VA benefits, what are covered by VA and what are not.
